even the wild beasts of the field,
- 9 The birds of the air, the fish of the sea,*
and whatsoever walks in the paths of the sea.

THE SECOND CANTICLE:

Either: A SONG OF THE MESSIAH

Refrain: **TO US A CHILD IS BORN, TO US A SON IS GIVEN;***
WHO IS CALLED MIGHTY GOD AND PRINCE OF PEACE.

- 1 The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light;*
those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness,
upon them the light has dawned.
- 2 You have increased their joy and given them great gladness;*
they rejoiced before you as with joy at the harvest.

born of the house of his servant, David.
- 3 Through his holy prophets he promised of old,*
that he would save us from our enemies,
from the hands of all that hate us,

and to remember his holy covenant.
- 5 This was the oath he swore to our father Abraham:*
to set us free from the hands of our enemies,
- 6 Free to worship him without fear,*
holy and righteous in his sight, all the days of our life.
- 7 You, my child, shall be called the prophet of the Most High,*
for you will go before the Lord to prepare his way,

- 8 To give his people knowledge of salvation,*
by the forgiveness of all their sins.
- 9 In the tender compassion of our God,*
the dawn from on high shall break upon us,
- 10 To shine on those who dwell in darkness and the shadow of death,*
and to guide our feet into the way of peace.
